From 1994 to 1996, he was with Siemens Power Transmission and Distribution Group in Erlangen, Germany. In 2001, he was a Visiting Professor at the University of Manitoba, Winnipeg, Canada. His research interests include power conditioners, FACTS devices, power quality and active distribution networks. In 2009, Dr. Papič with partners established Reinhausen 2e Ltd., a spin-off company of the University of Ljubljana. The main activities of the company include engineering and development of passive, hybrid and active compensators.

Currently, he is the dean of the Faculty of Electrical Engineering, University of Ljubljana, and head of the Laboratory of Electricity Networks and Devices.
